



HCPCS is an acronym for Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System. This system is a uniform method for healthcare providers and medical suppliers to report professional services, procedures and supplies. Prior to its development in 1983, there was no uniform system. A HCPCS code is a single letter, ranging from A to V, followed by a four-digit format.

CPT Codes

CPT is an acronym for official Current Procedural Terminology—the most widely accepted medical nomenclature used to report medical procedures and services under public and private health insurance programs.

ICD-9 Codes

ICD-9 Code is the acronym for the International Classification of Diseases, 9th Revision, Clinical Modification. It is a numeric diagnosis code with a corresponding written description of the diagnosis.
